MEETING LOCATION

The MenCare Global Meeting will be held at the following location on all three days, June 8 – June 10, 2017:

COST

There is no fee to participate in the MenCare Global Meeting. Unless otherwise indicated, however, the meeting organizers <u>will not</u> be able to fund participant costs related to travel, including transportation, accommodation, visa fees, or incidentals. These expenses will need to be covered by the traveler.

MENCARE GLOBAL MEETING PROGRAM

Registration will open at 8:00 on Thursday, June 8. The program will begin at 9:00 each day and close between 17:00 and 18:00, with one evening cocktail event on June 8th. The MenCare Global Meeting 2017 will be held during three days in Belgrade, Serbia on June 8–10, 2017. The meeting will bring together a diverse group of practitioners, activists, and researchers to share and exchange new findings, lessons learned, and reflections from the field of engaging men as fathers and caregivers for gender equality. The **main goals** of the meeting will be to:

- 1. Raise the profile of men's caregiving within the global advocacy agenda for 2017 and beyond;
- 2. Promote horizontal learning between organizations and people in order to strengthen ties among MenCare partners; and
- 3. Work together to develop new strategies for continuing the fight for gender equality amid rising challenges.
